I have written to Singer Sewing Machine about the 9th of March that the Custodian has send me a notice to pay up my balance. Well we are all unemployed it is very impossible for us to pay up all the balance but I have talk them that it would be easier for us to pay up in monthly. Singer Sewing Machine Co. has given me the answer that I could make a regular monthly payment of \$3.60. So I have sent \$10.80 about the end of March for the 3 months, which is November, December and January. I still have the balance of \$2.90 and I'm willing to pay up at every end of 3 months.

We wrote to you on the 3rd of March in connection with the claim against you by the Singer Sewing Machine Company, but have received no reply. They have since advised us that the balance owed by you is now \$42.90. They also show that the last installment was paid on the 4th of October, 1942. As your balance is not so very big we suggest that you pay up the monthly installments to date, and keep the payments up to date.

As you are aware, if these payments are not kept up to date, the Singer Sewing Machine Company would be entitled to repossess the machine. However, they have no wish to do so if the payments are made regularly.

Under the circumstances we would appreciate if you would let us have your cheque to bring your payments up to date. The cheque should be made out to the Custodian of Enemy Property.
