When HOMMA registered with the Custodian on June 22/42, he signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area. However in his letter of Mar. 22/43 he asks about household goods that his wife had left in the care of her mother Mrs. Soyo NISHI, at 8870 Selkirk St. He also states that his wife's sister had goods at this address. A shipment of certain articles was sent to Mrs. HOMMA, File 10945. The balance of the articles at this address were sold in the name of Mrs. Soyo NISHI. We sent the auction sheets to Mr. HOMMA and Mrs. HOMMA, Mrs. Soyo NISHI, and Mrs. HOMMA's sister, agreed that certain goods belonged to Mr. HOMMA and requested that proceeds from sale of these goods be transferred to the account of Mr. HOMMA. This transfer has been done and the account of Mr. HOMMA credited with the sum of \$37.22.

The Philco battery radio which he surrendered to the R.C.M.P. has been sold for the net sum of \$23.59.

DECLARATION AS TO LOST RADIO RECEIPT


I, Joseph HOMMA, of Greenwood, British Columbia, do hereby declare:
