

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on June 29, 1942, the day before she was evacuated.

In her declaration she reported a policy with the Prudential Life Insurance Co. This did not come under the control of this office.

In January, 1944 she inquired about a radio. This radio was surrendered by her father and was released to the B.C. Security Commission on April 6, 1944 for shipment to him.

Dear Madam:

Your request, of January 24th, for the return of your radio has been received.

Radios, owned by persons residing outside the province of British Columbia are being released to the British Columbia Security Commission for shipment to the owners in cases where the owners have requested shipment. The expense of packing and shipping is borne by the owners.

The radio about which you inquired was, according to our records, turned in by Kametaro AKIYAMA, your father. It would be necessary to establish the fact that this radio was your property, or to get your father's consent to the radio being shipped to you, before the Commission would make shipment. It would also be necessary to send the receipt from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police in making the request for shipment.

We suggest that you, or your father, write the British Columbia Security Commission, sending the receipt from the police, and make request for shipment.

It is possible that the reason you have had no reply from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police is that they have no record of a radio owned by you.
