When you made your declaration to the Custodian on June 30, 1942, you stated you owed the sum of \$80.00 for rent of premises at 237 Powell Street. It was arranged that either of the two Boilers situated on the above premises and owned by the previous tenant, Mrs. T. Yamamoto, who operated a Japanese Steam Bath, should be moved to the Canada Mio Building, 245 Powell St., for either storage or sale.

On removing the first boiler, it was found that it was entirely burned out and of no use. The other boiler was then moved to the back of the premises and it was immediately apparent that the back two sections were cracked and on removal of the asbestos covering from the front sections, it was found that the crack continued throughout the entire boiler and that this boiler was also unuseable. As there has already been approximately \$20.00 spent in labour in moving these boilers outside the premises and in view of the fact that they were of no use, there was obviously no point in spending a similar amount to replace them in the building.

An offer was made to purchase the boilers for scrap iron by Mr. J. Cameron (wrecker) at 50¢ per 100 pounds. This was made verbally to Mr. Wright, who instructed me to accept the offer. Mr. Cameron has now had these broken up and weighed on the City scales, and has today remitted to me the amount of \$10.00 and the Official Scale Ticket showing the weight to be 2020 pounds.

I am enclosing to you herewith my cheque for \$10.00 together with the Scale Ticket. *not enclosed*



YOUR FILE NO. 11097.

1. The personal property declared by the above is situated at the rear of the premises at 237 Powell Street, and consists mainly of the equipment of a steam bath.
2. The premises occupied are an unseparated part of the ground floor, the front of which was occupied by Isaburo Yamamoto, (Your File No. 2146), who has been evacuated and whose property was placed under my temporary control by your Office.
3. The owner of this building is a Japanese National located in Japan, and his Agent was the Japan and Canada Trust which, in turn, is now in the hands of Frederick Field and Company.
4. The rent is paid up to the end of February, 1942. There is, accordingly, four months' rent unpaid. This is apparently the only debt owed by this declarant.
5. On inspecting the listed property I found that the main articles of value had actually been sold, prior to Yamamoto completing his "JP" Declaration. These items are -
  - 1 electric washing machine
  - 1 electric fan
  - 1 bureau.I might also mention that there were only 2 electric fans originally - not three, and that the remaining one is broken.
6. The two baths, included in the Declaration, are so built that they are a part of the building and belong to the Landlord.
7. The remaining items could only be sold, if they can be sold, to a second-hand dealer and I do not think they would bring more than \$15.00. Will you therefore advise me as to whether I should prevent their sale by the Japanese and hold them against the claim for rent, which could be made by the Enemy Alien Section of your Office on behalf of the Japanese National Landlord, or whether, in view of the very small amount involved and the difficulty of disposing thereof, the Japanese should be permitted to dispose of them himself and retain any realization. I personally recommend the latter course.
8. Yamamoto advises me that he is reporting again tomorrow, the 9th current, to the Security Commission and will advise me of whatever instructions he receives.
