GENERAL SUMMARY

On June 30, 1942, this woman signed a declaration to the Custodian stating that she owned no property of any kind in the protected area.

However, the RCMP reported that she had surrendered a radio. This radio was turned over to the Custodian on May 27, 1944. In the RCMP Exhibit Report No. 202, and in the receipt which Mrs. NAKAMURA has sent to us, the radio is described as A. C. Electric Mohawk Serial No. D40198. On the auction sheet the radio is described as a Lyric Console (Electric), and is shown as RCMP No. 202. No explanation of the difference in description can be obtained. Since the net proceeds of \$12.04 were received for RCMP 202, according to auction sheet, these funds are being remitted to Mrs. NAKAMURA.

At Auction #21, May 31, 1944, Vancouver, there was sold under RCMP No. 202, a Lyric Console Radio. The net proceeds of this sale have been credited to the account of Mrs. NAKAMURA, in the amount of \$12.04.

RCMP Report 202 and the receipt given to Mrs. NAKAMURA describe her radio as AD Electric Mahawk No. D-42198.

If the radio sold as RCMP 202 was the property of Mrs. NAKAMURA the description on auction sheet must be wrong. If the description on auction sheet is correct in regard to the article sold, then the radio could not be that of Mrs. NAKAMURA. However, we are sending the proceeds from this sale to Mrs. NAKAMURA, as her radio was appraised as being worth \$10.00 and probably would have been worth the amount credited to her account.
