GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: George UYEHARA, Reg. No. 12094

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 14, 1942.  
He was evacuated on August 27, 1942.

In his declaration he reported no real property or chattels, and none are revealed on his file.

UYEHARA reported the sum of \$375.00 due him from the Trans-Pacific Lumber Company Ltd. for the sale of boom equipment. On July 8, 1942, this sum was received from the Trans-Pacific Lumber Company Ltd., and credited to the account of George UYEHARA. One cheque for \$75.00 was requisitioned and handed to UYEHARA prior to his evacuation, leaving the balance of \$300.00 in the account.

UYEHARA declared a policy with the Prudential Life. This was not brought under the control of this office.

This file reveals no liabilities.
