

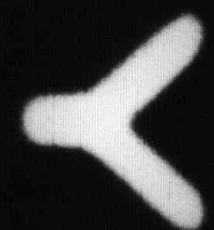

SUMMARY of LIABILITIES

The above Japanese person did not declare any debts on his Form J card dated July 7, 1942, but a review of his file reveals the following claims were lodged against him:

Komura Bros. Limited -	.20
B. C. Telephone Company -	3.79

On March 29, 1943 we wrote to TEHARA advising him of the above two claims outstanding on his file and in his reply dated April 7, 1943 he informed us he had never bought anything from Komura Bros. while he lived in Vancouver. We advised Komura Bros. accordingly on April 15, 1943, at which time we gave them Tehara's address that they might write to him direct if they so wished as the Custodian was taking no further action regarding this small claim. We advised Mr. Tehara of our action on this matter.

In connection with the claim by the B. C. Telephone Company, the above Evacuee stated he did not owe this Company any money as he paid his account on June 19th or 20th before evacuation. We advised the B. C. Telephone Company of this and they stated in reply that this Japanese person had not notified them to cancel his telephone as at July 9, 1942 but that in view of his having paid his June account and being evacuated on July 9, 1942 they would cancel the above charge. We advised Mr. Tehara accordingly on April 22, 1943.

NO OTHER CLAIMS AGAINST THE ABOVE JAPANESE PERSON ARE REVEALED ON THIS FILE.


