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PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Jinnosuke MORITA, Reg. No. 03059

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on August 4, 1942. He had also signed a declaration on July 7, 1942. He had been evacuated on March 7, 1942, but apparently returned to the city to assist his family at the time of the evacuation of the other members. His wife was evacuated on September 28, 1942.

In his declaration of July 7, 1942, MORITA stated that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area. In the declaration of August 4, 1942, which is on a sheet headed Additional Registration, he reported:

Life Insurance: 1. Occidental Life Insurance Company Policy #1266120.  
2. Monarch Life Insurance Co. No. unknown (No. was 117537)

These were not brought under the control of this office.

These he stated were to be left at 1332 Seymour Street, and the key to be given to the neighbours at 1328 Seymour Street. The key to be handed to the owner of the premises when he came to collect. An undated notation, signed "J.F. Trumbull" on the back of the copy of JP form states that "the house is vacant. Morita chattels not there. Have been evacuated to Slocan and taken personal belongings with same. Gallagher handling sale of house." On November 5, 1942, we informed MORITA of this. He replied November 9, 1942, that he had reported his property to the Custodian and most of his personal property should have been taken over by the Custodian. Mr. Logan visited the premises, according to memo of December 9, 1942, and found no chattels at 1332 Seymour. W.H. Gallagher & Co., agents for the house, had stated that nothing but rubbish had been left on the premises when the Japanese evacuated. MORITA has not confirmed the reports that his personal effects were taken away by himself.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$5.89, as refund of one per cent wage deductions for the first six months of 1941.
