The sum of \$6.82 was recovered by us from the Provincial Collector, representing a refund of income tax on the wages of the above for the first six months of 1941. This amount is his only credit balance with this office.

The above declared fourteen \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

SHARES:

On August 19th, 1942, he declared oil royalties in charge of Yoshiichi YOSHIKOTO, agent for Cross Clifton & Co. These royalties were owned by his wife Kyo. The shares were liquidated for the sum of \$495.00, and this amount was remitted to him on September 4th, 1942, with a request that the cheque be handed to his wife. This cheque not acknowledged by either the wife or husband.

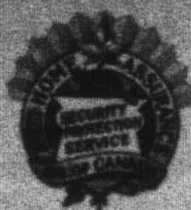

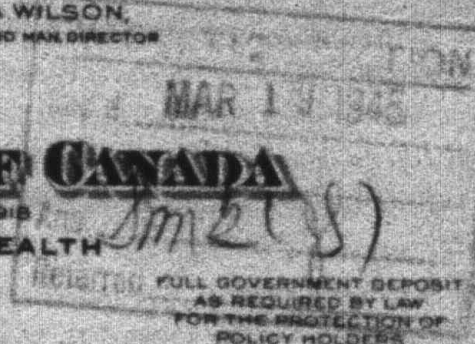

In your declaration to the Custodian you declared ownership of fourteen \$5.00 War Savings Certificates, in your own possession. You declared a savings account in the Royal Bank of Canada in the sum of \$1350.00. You also declared a \$1000.00 life insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co. The foregoing securities did not come under the control of the Custodian.

A policy in the Home Assurance Co. was surrendered by you to the insurance company, and the cash surrender value in the sum of \$88.67 was forwarded to you with our letter of March 19th, 1943.
