GENERAL SUMMARY

Re OIKAWA, Kaoru #24751

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 10, 1942. She was evacuated on September 8, 1942.

In her official declaration Mrs. OIKAWA reported only the following: "Group Insurance Prudential Life Insurance Co, 510 Hastings St., Vancouver, B. C. 5 Children, Tachio, Shimizu, Shingo, Makoto, Kaoru, \$5.00 per month, \$1,000.00 20 year endowment. Paid to date. Policy No. unknown. In (Makoto) boy's possession. Beneficiary: mother (Kaoru)." This item was not brought under the control of this office.

On August 18, 1942, Mrs. OIKAWA requested the Custodian to remove to storage from 214 East Cordova, one dresser, one bookstand, one dining-room table, 2 cabinets, one gramophone, 2 end-tables, one coil spring, 3 wire springs, 2 enamel bedsteads. These items were stored in 992 Powell Street warehouse, and on February 18, 1944, were handed to the B. C. Security Commission for shipment to Mrs. OIKAWA.

The R.C.N.P. reported that this woman had surrendered a radio. This was handed to the Custodian, and was sold on December 20, 1943, for the net sum of \$31.06, which has been credited to the account of Mrs. OIKAWA.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

This file reveals no liabilities, as Dr. N. Uchida withdrew his claim of \$3.00.

We are in receipt of your letter of the 23rd ultimo in respect to funds on hand here to the credit of your father SAOTO OIKAWA, Reg. No. 02760.

On receipt of same we took the matter up with the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, Vancouver, and have just received a reply as follows:-

"We have for acknowledgment your letter of the 30th ulto.,


According to our records no funds are now held by you on behalf of Katsushige, and as his parents are residing in our New Denver Project we cannot recommend that their funds be released to them.

As far as we know Mr. and Mrs. Oikawa have expressed no desire to leave New Denver to take a residence in Ontario."

It will therefore be necessary for you to take the matter up with your father and have him discuss his plans with the Department of Labour, New Denver, where he is residing, so that they will be in a position to advise this office regarding the release of his funds. On hearing from him and the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, we shall give consideration to the matter.

MEMORANDUM

To: The Files  
From: Mr. H. F. Green

Re: Naota OIKAWA - 222 Clark DE.

Mrs. Oikawa declared no effects, but wrote to us on August 18, 1942 to store some things she had left at 215 E. Cordova. This was done, the list acknowledged by her as correct and complete, and finally in December, 1943, shipment of all these articles was applied for and made in February, 1944 by the Security Commission.

Mr. Oikawa declared considerable effects at this address, but it appears from correspondence dated July 30, 1942 that this was under the care of his wife and therefore covered by the first paragraph of this memo. On August 3, 1942, Mr. Oikawa wrote that the furniture was no longer under the care of the Custodian. There is a letter from Mrs. Oikawa October 25, 1943 referring to a storeroom, but investigation shows there to be no chattles on the premises, and it appears as if this letter was an afterthought, being an attempt to get extra revenue.
