A review of your file discloses a credit balance in your favour in the sum of \$52.41 representing refund of taxes, made up of two amounts, namely, \$3.40 for 1941 and \$49.01 for 1942.

It is also noted that there is a claim filed against you by Gihei KAWABARA in the sum of \$66.99 as explained to you in our letter of July 17th, 1942. As we wish to close out these small balances in our accounts, we shall be pleased to know if we may transfer your credit balance to the credit of Gihei KAWABARA as a partial payment of his claim.

When Mrs. Tanouye made her declaration to the Custodian she declared a treadle sewing machine left in care of Mr. S. Hayden. We have been unable to contact Mrs. Hayden to determine if she is still in possession of your sewing machine. When replying please inform us if the sewing machine is still in her care, or if it was disposed of by Mrs. Tanouye prior to her evacuation.

GENERAL SUMMARY

RE: Yachiho (Mrs. Shigeo) TANOUYE

Mrs. TANOUYE made her declaration to the Custodian on July 10/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 10/42. She declared the following goods left in care of Mr. C.P. Berettoni of the Rainier Beer Parlor at 309 Carrall St.

3 boxes kitchen utensils
1 double bed with spring and mattress

She also declared she had left a Singer sewing machine with Mrs. S. Hayden, 309 Carrall St.

We wrote to Mr. Berettoni on June 18/43 regarding these goods and he advised us that Mrs. TANOUYE had taken these articles with her when she left Vancouver.

We also wrote to Mrs. Hayden regarding the sewing machine on June 18/43, but she did not reply to our letter. We wrote to Mr. TANOUYE on Aug. 6/46 and advised him that Mrs. Hayden had not replied to our letter regarding the sewing machine. We asked him to let us know whether it was still with her or whether he and his wife had taken it with them at the time of their evacuation. Mr. TANOUYE did not reply to this letter so it would appear that they either have the sewing machine with them or are satisfied to leave it with Mrs. Hayden.

Mrs. TANOUYE declared three \$5.00 War Savings Certificates belonging to her daughter in her possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

We were advised by the Prudential Insurance Co. that Mrs. TANOUYE and her daughter Yako both had policies with their company. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

There are no claims on file against Mrs. TANOUYE.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
