Will you please transfer from the account of Mrs. OIKAWA to Chattel Suspense Account, the following:

Chest of drawers sold at Vancouver Auction #32 for \$1.00

Mrs. OIKAWA in letter of August 13/42 declared 2 wire springs and 2 bedsteads complete. However all we found was one bed spring and 2 wood bed ends and 2 wood bed sides. We advised her we had found these and she confirmed that this was all the property she had in the protected area by signing and returning our list. At no time did she make any mention of a chest of drawers being among goods left. This would therefore seem to have been credited to her in error.
