

This boat appears to have been owned by I. MIYASAKI.

Yaichi MIYASAKI, Internee File 433, declared ownership of a speed boat left at Ocean Falls.

The engine taken from the boat was a Farrow, Serial #42874. This engine appears to be the one sold as Engine 121, described as an Evinrude Outboard, Model 1065, Serial 42874. From this sale the sum of \$20.00 has been credited to the account of Yaichi MIYASAKI.
