With regard to the second paragraph of your letter, would you be good enough to advise us what goods are held for Mr. SAKAI of Winnipeg, and other Japanese, on separate itemized lists, and it will be necessary for you to get in touch with us before making shipments to these different persons.

We are sorry to give you this trouble but a number of the Japanese are claiming for lost chattels, and we would like to have the information asked for.

We have just received a letter from Mrs T. Okawa Reg.No.03233, requesting us to send on their belongings, which have been stored here since the evacuation. We are enclosing a list of the articles. May we have your permission to forward these things?

We take this opportunity to let you know that Mr Sakai of Winnipeg has asked us to send his belongings, he is also planning to get in touch with the other Japanese who have goods stored here, to find out what they want done with them. Will it be permissible to send them to their owners when they ask for them. We are awaiting further word from Mr Sakai regarding his own belongings, as he has not said definitely how or when he wants them shipped.

Hoping to receive a reply at your earliest convenience, especially regarding Okawa's things as they are leaving for the east early in August and would like to take them with them. We are,

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS: The above who registered with the Custodian on July 11/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 23/42, signed a yellow "No property" card stating that she had no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia, and none was found belonging to her.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: A radio and camera which the above had surrendered to the R.C.M.P. on Mar. 10/42 were turned over by them to the Custodian. The Lafayette radio was sold at auction for the net sum of \$46.04 and this sum credited to the account of the above with this office. The camera was mailed to her on July 21/46.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
