

This 68-year old Logger, a Japanese-National, from Indian River, B. C., signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 11th July, 1942. He was evacuated on the 23rd September, 1942, and repatriated to Japan on the 17th June, 1946, per S.S. "General Naigyo".

His wife, Michie, resides in Japan.

This file has been reviewed today and discloses no evidence of either assets or liabilities.
