



This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 11, 1942. In his declaration he reported a 1940 Ford car in custody of the R.C.M.P., Vancouver. This car was sold and the net proceeds in the amount of \$598.02 were credited to this man's account.

In his declaration he reported a bank account with a balance of \$15.00 in the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver. This did not come under the control of this office.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$85.24 in payment of packing and shipping of film. This amount was remitted to him on February 19, 1943.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$204.73 received from Messrs. Lawrence & Tuttle of Seattle, being refund of duties paid to customs.

On May 11, 1943 and July 10, 1943, this man's account was debited with the amount of \$435.00 paid to the Royston Savings Association being repayment of \$400.00 loan plus \$35.00 interest. This man was not a shareholder.

On December 22, 1942, the amount of \$31.01 was paid to Komura Bros. in settlement of a claim filed by them.

On December 22, 1942, the amount of \$2.50 was paid to M. UCHIDA in settlement of a claim filed by him.

On March 8, 1943, the amount of \$22.86 was paid to Tasaburo CHAKI in settlement of a claim filed by him.

On July 17, 1943, the amount of \$5.00 was paid to Leith & Dyke Ltd. in settlement of a claim filed by that firm.

On December 16, 1942 we remitted \$200.00 to TSUYUKI and on July 20, 1943 we remitted \$106.38 to TSUYUKI.
