The above mentioned and her 3 children (age 5, 4 and 2) together with husband, at present visiting here, are proceeding to Montreal to make their home.

Mrs. Tanaka requests her furniture sent from Vancouver to Montreal, and we have made out the necessary Custodian release form covering this shipment. The furniture is stored in the home of Mr. Small, 1207 Hall Street, Vancouver, B. C.

The approximate shipping weight of the effects, stated, would be about 1500 pounds. If it exceeds this amount, Mrs. Tanaka requests the chesterfield suite to be left out. There will be no freight shipped from here free for this family, as the 1500 pounds to be shipped from Vancouver covers the freight allowance.

Mr. Tanaka has written Mr. Small asking him to have the effects crated and ready for the Custodian to pick up. This being the case, we believe there will be no crating charge.
