
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:


This 45-year old Housewife, a Japanese National, from Allison Harbour, B. C., signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 13th July, 1942. She was evacuated on the 9th September, 1942.

Her husband, Denjiro (File 15350), signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 24th November, 1943. He was evacuated on the 19th March, 1942.

This file has been reviewed today and discloses no evidence of either assets or liabilities.
