GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 11380 Goro TAHARA, Deceased

Reg. No. 07605.

Goro Tahara died at Ashcroft, B. C. on February 19, 1945. According to information on file, the deceased was sixty-five years of age and single. The file reveals no relatives.

Goro Tahara declared no assets to the Custodian and none are revealed on the file.

A letter dated March 19, 1945, was received from P. J. Wilson, the Official Administrator at Lillooet, B. C. stating that the deceased appeared to have some wages coming to him for logs which he cut at Taylor Lake. He was advised by this office that the Custodian had no knowledge of any assets belonging to this Japanese, and nothing further was heard from the Official Administrator regarding the estate.

No claims appear on this file.
