

GENERAL SUMMARY

Kakusuke KURAOKA

This 63-year old Logger, a Japanese-National, from Coombs, B. C., signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 14th July, 1942. He was evacuated on the 27th August, 1942. He died at Tashme on the 7th March, 1946.

He declared his wife, Tomie, and children (3), to be living in Japan.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Personal Property: None declared. Personal effects listed by the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, at time of death were subsequently turned over to the Japanese Committee for issuance to needy persons (see Nov. 22/46).

Bonds, Shares, etc.: War Savings Certificates (6 @ \$5.00) declared on "JP" form remained in owner's possession. In addition another War Savings Certificate (\$5.00) found in the offices of the Cameron Lake Logging Company, was mailed to this evacuee on Apr. 26/44.

Liabilities: None.

Funds: There is a balance of \$42.00 standing at the credit of this account at the present time, representing wage payments by the Department of Labour.

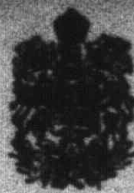

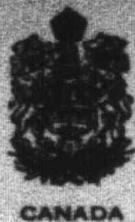

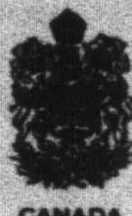
Upon reviewing the file of the above deceased Japanese, we notice that you advised us on March 15, 1946, that KURACKA's effects had been placed in storage at Tashme.
