RESEARCH STEEL STATE File 11385. Kakusuko KURACKA Reg. No. 07292. This 63-year old Logger, a Japanese-Mational, from Goombe, B. C., signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 14th July, 1942. He was evecuated on the 27th August, 1942. He died at Tashme on the 7th March, 1946. He declared his wife, Tomie, and children (3), to be living in Japan. 
