As most of my papers and books were
left in Vancouver in storage when I was sent
to Red Pass Road Camp in March 1942,
I have no means of verifying whether the
above quoted amount is correct or not. To the
best of my knowledge I believe the amount
was about one hundred dollars less than
has been claimed by Mr. Takasaki. I will be
glad to pay what I owe, when I am able to
do so, but at the present time, I am having
quite a struggle, just to feed and clothe
my family and it is impossible to save
even a penny for any other purpose.
