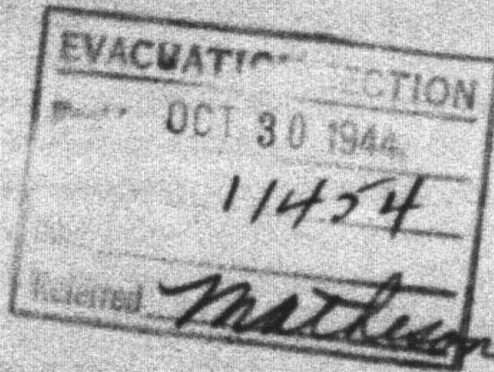

On May 10, 1942, according to the war time regulations on the people of Japanese origin, I have turned over my camera (six-20 brownie) to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police at 33rd West Avenue, Vancouver, B. C. The receipt number is 12300. And now it is in the custody of your office.

I understand that if one relocates East, the camera will be returned. I have come to Alma College, St. Thomas Ontario, on September 20 and have reported to the R.C.M.P. in London concerning my camera, and they have suggested that I write to you so that you will be able to send it to me directly or to the R.C.M.P. office in London.

In receipt of my camera, I shall send the receipt immediately to you.

I shall appreciate to receive the camera as soon as possible. Thank you.
