Dear Sir:-

You will recall declaring tools valued at \$150.00 in the care of the Pacific Shingle Company, Indian River. We have recently contacted Mr. Thompson of the Pacific Shingle Co. and this gentleman has introduced us to an independent appraiser who has recently visited the Indian River operation. This gentleman reports that the saws, axes, and wedges left there are very worn and of little value, but that there are thirty or forty sledge hammers in good shape. We do not know whether we shall be able to secure any offers for the sale of what remains there, failing which it will just stay where it is. If you have any suggestions, please advise.


Dear Sirs:- Re:- Your files - #11456 and #11468

Further to the writer's conversation with your Mr. Green and your subsequent letter of November 29th, we have now received a report from our former watchman at Indian River, being as follows:-

"I finally got around to making the trip up to the camp, found two of the houses had been broken into couldn't tell if anything had been taken. I made a rough inventory of the Jap tools it works out about as follows:- saws - 32; picks - 1; peevies - 5; axes - 5; hammers - 5; wedges - 180 pounds (in weight); I could not very well open them up (the several bundles) to make a count. There are some small tools such as saw-handles etc. in with the wedges."

No idea as to the cost or the time required to bring these tools down to tide-water was given. We doubt that the expense of their removal would be warranted as all the tools are second hand ones.
