

We regret to advise that your radio has been sold, in accordance with the Custodian's policy of liquidation. The net sum of \$43.01 was realized from this sale, and this sum has been placed to your credit in our trust account.

Your camera is in our hands.

If you will send us the receipt which you received when you surrendered the radio and camera, we will have the camera sent to you by registered mail, deducting the cost of mailing from the funds in your account. The cost of mailing will be approximately a dollar.

Ordinarily the balance from the sale of your redic could be sent to you when the radio receipt is in our hands. However, your file contains a claim filed by Rinkichi Tagashire & Company for the sum of \$184.93. The claim is filed against Mr. and Mrs. T. C. Miyesaki, Indian River.
