With reference to the claim of \$184.93 which you lodged with the Custodian some time ago against the above named. We wrote to him regarding your claim and we have now received his reply. The following is an extract from his letter which is self explanatory.

"May I state that this claim by R. Tagashira against me and my wife is utterly incorrect. Previously, presumably this same firm placed claim against Mrs. MIYASAKI, my wife, for which she requested information as we do not recollect the indebtedness.

"If R. Tagashira wishes to press this collection of this untrue debt, I would be much obliged if you will reply regarding same immediately. Also I would be much obliged if you will let me know the address of R. Tagashira."

In order that this matter may be straightened out in the very early future, we ask you to reply to this letter at your very earliest convenience as other business is being held up pending your reply. If we do not hear from you before the 22nd of November, 1944, we will assume that you agree that MIYASAKI'S statement is correct and that you have no claim against him.

Dear Sir:

Mr. C. G. Shantz has written us on your behalf in connection with your radio.

We regret to advise that your radio has been sold, in accordance with the Custodian's policy of liquidation. The net sum of \$43.01 was realized from this sale, and this sum has been placed to your credit in our trust account.

Your camera is in our hands.

If you will send us the receipt which you received when you surrendered the radio and camera, we will have the camera sent to you by registered mail, deducting the cost of mailing from the funds in your account. The cost of mailing will be approximately a dollar.

Ordinarily the balance from the sale of your radio could be sent to you when the radio receipt is in our hands. However, your file contains a claim filed by Rinkichi Tagashira & Company for the sum of \$184.93. The claim is filed against Mr. and Mrs. T. C. Miyasaki, Indian River. We would therefore be pleased if you would let us know if this claim is correct, and, if so, how you propose to settle it.

Until this claim is cleared up, the radio money will be held. However, if you wish to have your camera, you could send us the receipt, and we will send you in return a letter of acknowledgement which would take the place of the receipt.
