

Witness: Appraiser, D. Dodding.

Appraiser (Dodding) reported - House 20 years old. Land in poor state of tilth. This is a small holding which has two main drawbacks, the soil is of poor quality and the property carries too many buildings that are not revenue producing. The poultry houses are deteriorating rapidly. The five small outhouses are of no value.

Claimant agreed that the soil was not too good but the main business which he carried on on this property was the raising of chickens.

It was submitted that the real property was sold for its fair market value.

Claims for Pipes \$80. and Water Tank \$150. were abandoned as these were sold with the real property and the claim for the dining room suite was reduced by \$30. (Trans. Page 8) These goods were left on the property in care of the tenant, H. GUINETE, who agreed that he would be responsible for them. This arrangement was made by claimant's father with the authority of claimant. The goods were declared by claimant's father in his J.P. Form as Stove, Pump and Household Furniture, no mention being made of the two Incubators, for which claimant is claiming \$150.

Claimant's father remained on the premises for about 6 months after claimant was evacuated and then let the premises to H. GUINETTE with claimant's permission. (Trans.page 10).

Claimant stated that his father handled the whole of the negotiations made with the tenant.

Other goods sold by auction and tender for \$14.55 were not included in the claim.
