PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS: The above Japanese registered with this office on the 20th July, 1942, and declared leaving 4 boxes of chinaware, kitchen cabinet and 5 chairs stored in one room of house built on his brother's property.

This property was inventoried by our fieldmen on the 1st September, 1942, as per attached schedule. A copy of this inventory was sent to ABE on the 22nd September 1942, and which he returned signed as correct, 2nd October, 1942.

A request from ABE through the B.C. Security Commission, was received 12th Jan. 1944, for shipment of chinaware, art equipment etc. The goods were shipped to him 24th February, 1944.

In December 1945, certain chattels were moved from Mr. G.D. Percy's, Lougheed Highway, to auction at Haney, and among these goods were some marked "Y. ABE". Mr. ABE was written to 7th February, 1946, to which he replied 9th February, that he had left some goods in Mr. Percy's care (See attached schedule).

These goods were found to have been sold at Haney Auctions #17 & 18, 16th Nov. and 5th Dec. 1945, with the exception of the Beatty Washing machine and a fur neckpiece. Mr. Percy was written to on the 15th Feb. 1946, but no reply was received, and nothing further was done at that time. We recently endeavoured to contact Mr. Percy in connection with records of the Japanese School Maintainers Association, File No. 9754, but he had moved away, and we have been unable to trace him.

The balance of the chattels in the house formerly occupied by ABE, were abandoned as not being worth the expense of handling.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: This file reveals no specified articles.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE: On the 12th April, 1943, the Provincial Income Tax Dept. forwarded the sum of \$4.93 to this office, being a refund of ABE's 1941 Income tax.

In July 1945, the sum of \$3.00 was received from the B.C. Electric Rlwy. Co. being a refund of his light security deposit.

BONDS & INVESTMENTS: ABE declared having a number of War Savings Certificates, but these were not brought under control by the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT: Although Yoshimaru ABE did not declare having a bank account, a notice was received in January, 1946, from the Bank of Montreal, Haney, that they held an account for the Japanese. This was not brought under control by the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE: ABE declared a \$1000.00 North American Life Insurance policy, but this was not brought under control or administered in any way by the Custodian.

This file reveals no other personal property assets.

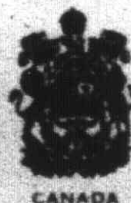




