On writing to Mr. Sakamura regarding this claim he stated he had settled this account prior to his departure from Vancouver. This was confirmed by G. Yamada, Managing Director of the above Company, in a letter dated April 21, 1943, on file.

2. A.C. Purchasers' Cooperative Ass. - \$18.47 and
3. Sakura Products Distributing Co. Ltd. - \$32.74

In an undated letter received by the Custodian March 14, 1947, Mitsuo Sakamura stated the above claims were not correct, as he paid every cent to the respective salesman. Accordingly, we advised Harris & Macleod on April 23, 1947 that Mr. Sakamura denied owing money to the above associations and suggested that they contact this Japanese person direct regarding these two claims. No further action being taken by the Custodian in this regard.

Custodian cheque for these amounts is being forwarded to Mr. Nakamura in the course of a few days.


Shares:

An extract on file dated January 12, 1944 reveals that the above Japanese person holds 10 shares in the B. C. Purchasers Association. According to Messrs. Norris & MacLennan's letter on file dated February 19, 1947, the Secretary of the above Association has asked for permission to start making a distribution of funds on hand to the members in connection with this Association and Mr. Shears has requested that, as there may be some of the members who are classed as "enemies" and others who, while being evacuees, may have admitted debts which are recorded on their individual files, they (Norris & MacLennan) prepare and supply us with a list of the distribution which it is intended to make and we will then check our files and advise them of any interest which we have. No further information appears on file to date.

Life Insurance: This file reveals that Nakamura had a Mutual Life Insurance Policy, No. 525376. On September 23, 1943, Mr. Nakamura requested us to withdraw his insurance and we in turn wrote to the Mutual Life Insurance Company, Vancouver, giving them a copy of Nakamura's letter to us and requesting them to forward the necessary forms of application in connection with the cashing in of this policy, at the same time advising Nakamura what action we had taken. No further reference to life insurance appears on file.

We have for acknowledgement your letter of April 15th and now enclose Custodian cheque in the sum of \$17.11, being your entire credit with this office. The above amount represents refund of one per cent of wage deductions for the first half of 1941 in the amount of \$5.27 and refund of security deposit from the B. C. Electric Company in the amount of \$11.84.

We have advised Messrs. Morris & MacLennan, who are acting for Farmers' Products Distributing Company Limited and B. C. Purchasers' Cooperative Association, of your comments in connection with the claims lodged against you by the above Associations.

Under date of July 20, 1942 this Japanese person signed our Form J card certifying that he had no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area in British Columbia. A review of this file reveals the following:

Accounts Receivable: Refund of 15% wage deductions for the first half of 1941 received from the Provincial Collector, Vancouver, - \$5.27

Refund of Security Deposit for Light from the B. C. Electric Company in the total amount of - - - - \$11.84

The above amounts are held to the credit of this Japanese with the Custodian, total amount being \$17.11.

Shares:

An Extract on file dated January 12, 1944 reveals that the above Japanese person holds 10 shares in the B. C. Purchasers Association. These Associations are now receiving special consideration by the Custodian.

Life Insurance:

The file reveals a Mutual Life Insurance Policy, No. 525376. On September 23, 1943 Nakamura requested us to withdraw his insurance and we in turn wrote to the Mutual Life, Vancouver, giving them a copy of Nakamura's letter to us and asking them to forward the necessary forms of application in connection with cashing in this policy, at the same time advising Nakamura what action we had taken.

CLAIMS against Nakamura:

1. West Coast Trading Co. Ltd. - \$92.85

This claim settled, as per letter dated Apr. 21/43 from Geo Tanaka, Managing Director of above Company.

2. B. C. Purchasers Cooperative Assn. - \$18.47 and

Farmer's Products Distributing Co. Ltd. - \$30.74

On March 29/43 we wrote to Nakamura regarding these claims but received no reply. On April 8/43 we wrote to Norris & MacLennan regarding the above claims and they replied on Apr. 11/43 advising that these accounts are still owing, and the above-mentioned amounts being correct. According to the file no further action has been taken with regard to these two claims.
