



Sun Life Insurance Co., policy #2265,836 - \$1500.00, in which his wife Kikuye, file 7981, was the beneficiary.


The cash surrender value of this - \$29.38 - was taken by him on October 2nd, 1944 and the cheque for same sent to the Custodian by Sun Life Insurance Co., was forwarded to Kitagawa on October 4th, 1944.

On behalf of Sotojiro KITAGAWA the Custodian received a refund of \$5.80 from the Provincial Collector, representing 1% Wage Deductions for first six months of 1941.

July 8th, 1946.

Sotojiro KITAGAWA made his declaration to the Custodian on July 20th, 1942, but was evacuated on February 24th, 1942.

Although this Japanese person declared a quantity of personal effects left at South Westminster, and the Custodian prepared an inventory of items found under date of November 4th, 1942; as the result of our enquiries, KITAGAWA admitted in his letter of May 15th, 1945 that all his stored goods were disposed of by himself, and it is

assumed that he did not consider the above articles listed on on report of Nov 4th 1942 as of any value.
