CHATELS:

Ichizo HAYASHINUMA, when he registered with the Custodian, signed a yellow "no property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia. Mrs. HAYASHINUMA, when she made her declaration to the Custodian on July 15/42, declared 1 bed and 4 boxes of kitchen utensils left in the Fairview Buddhist Church at 715 W. 7th Ave., Vancouver. The 4 boxes of kitchen utensils were shipped to Mr. HAYASHINUMA on Custodian release dated Feb. 26/43. Receipt for this shipment is on file 11561.

The bed was not found or specifically identified. There were several old unidentified beds in this building which had no value and these were given to the War salvage, so it is probable that the bed declared by Mrs. HAYASHINUMA was among those discarded.

The file reveals the above persons did not own any specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
