SUMMARY OF LIABILITIES

The following claims against the above Japanese person are revealed on this file:

Dr. M. Uchida (\$21.00 and \$5.00) - \$26.00

Dr. D. A. Tompsett - \$50.00

The claim filed by Dr. M. Uchida was withdrawn. No further action by the Custodian required in connection with this claim.

We advised Mr. Mura under dated of December 30th, 1942 of Dr. Tompsett's account. Mr. Mura replied in a letter dated February 8, 1943, that he had Dr. Tompsett look after his daughter's leg but that at that time he had made arrangements whereby he would not have to pay the doctor.

On February 25, 1943 we wrote to Dr. Tompsett giving him an extract from Mura's letter to us regarding this claim and asking for further particulars. On April 6, 1944, Dr. Tompsett forwarded additional information to us which clearly indicated that this debt was incurred for treatment to Mura's daughter, Yoka, on May 22, 1942. We advised Mura in our letter of April 12, 1944, of Dr. Tompsett's reply and he in turn wrote to us on April 22, 1944 stating that at the time of treatment Miss Baldwin of the Seikakai Nursery School had told him she had made arrangements so that he would not have to pay the doctor and therefore Mura thought the account was settled.

We wrote to Dr. Tompsett on April 28, 1944 advising him that Mr. Mura admitted the claim but was unable to pay owing to his financial circumstances and as he had no assets with the Custodian we could not effect collection and were therefore taking no further action in the matter. We gave Dr. Tompsett this Evacuee's address in case he should wish to write to him direct, and advised the Evacuee accordingly. See below 1

The claims on this file require no further action by the Custodian.

1 - March 7/47 K. Mura advised that he could not pay Dr. Tompsett's claim under the present conditions and states he will be much obliged if we will wait until he is able to pay.

On receipt of your letter of the 6th inst. regarding account noted by you as against Mrs. Taita Mura, 1652 West 2nd Avenue, with particulars of your claim, we wrote to Kuniyei MURA. He now admits owing the amount but states that he is unable to pay, owing to his financial circumstances. We quote from his letter as follows:

"I am very sorry but I am unable to pay this debt. I have lots of children and a small wage and am very hard up and have to get maintenance to feed and clothe my children. At the present I cannot say how or when I can pay the debt, with conditions being as they are."

He has not declared any assets on his registration form with the Custodian and has no funds on hand with us.

In view of the foregoing it is obvious that we cannot effect collection of this account.
