

On March 9th, 1943, the above made application for refund of 1% income tax for the year 1941. This refund in the sum of \$5.42 was received from the Provincial Collector on April 12/43 and credited to the account of the above in this office. A Custodian cheque in this sum was remitted to Keiju SATO on May 14/45. This closed his account with this office.
