PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Mr. Eitaro TANOUYE, Reg. No. 08801

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 21st, 1942 in which he stated that he owned no property in the protected area.

A refund of 1% wage deductions for the first six months of 1942 was received from the Provincial Government in the amount of \$5.17, which was credited to the account of this man. This sum was remitted to him on March 19th, 1943.

The Chattel Schedule on this file shows the disposition of chattels declared by Mrs. Echi TANOUYE, wife of this man. It would appear from this Schedule that one box of kitchen utensils declared by Mrs. TANOUYE was not accounted for. It is not definite that this box is missing as the records of Chemainus chattels are not entirely complete. The sum of \$5.07 which was credited to the account of Mrs. TANOUYE from the sale of some chattels other than kitchen utensils is being transferred to Chattels Suspense.

- 1 box kitchen utensils left at Mrs. T. KAWABE (bunkhouse) - Although a carton is inventoried, a trunk and contents were sold.
- Mr. TANOUYE in Custodian Release - These were shipped to him on Nov. 20/42. dated Nov. 4/42 asks for shipment of one new mattress and one empty shoya sauce tub, left at the KAWABE Camp, Chemainus

Neither Mr. or Mrs. TANOUYE declared a trunk or the health machine and asthma lamp which would appear to have been in the trunk. I believe these goods have been incorrectly credited.
