This file reveals that Masanori HAYAKAWA owned no real property in any protecte area of B.C. and carried no Fire Insurance.

CHATTELS: He made his declaration to the Sustodian on July 21/42 and was evaluated on July 24/42. To declared no chattels and none were found by the Sustodian belonging to him.

SPECIFED On March 13/42he surrendered to the R.C.M.P. a Pada radio and they ARTIGLES: turned this radio over to the Custodian on Dec. 17/43. A Victor cabinet only was sold in his name at Vancouver Radio Auction #1 for the net sum of \$8.36. There is no explanation on file as to how we took over a Fada radio and sold a Victor cabinet. The \$8.36 from sale of the sum of the s

radio is his only credit with the Gustodian.

Mr. S. S. SASAKI surrendered to the R.C.M.P. on behalf of Mikio HAYAKAWA, son of Masanori HAYAKAWA, the following cameras:

These are still in our warehouse. In letter being written to HAYAKAWA we are asking him if he wishes these cameras shipped. The receipt for the cameras is on file. Cameras shipped Jan. 16/47 and coof packing & mailing (72¢) was deducted from his credit with this office

WAR SAVINGS He declared eighteen \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his own CERTIFICATES: possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.



The receipt did not come back with the answer so the Custodian should have my receipt for two cameras. I have the answer which I received at that time, if that would help. One of them were Ansco, post-card size, folding type; the other was a Box-type, Baby Brownie--size 620.

A claim in the sum of \$15.87 is filed against us by Ur. Masajiro Kimura.
