Miss HOSHINO registered with the Custodian on July 22/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 8/42. She signed a yellow "No property" card stating she owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of B.C.

On March 9/42 she surrendered to the R.C.M.P. a DeForest radio mental type, Serial No. C70659. They turned this radio over to the Custodian on Feb. 17/44 and it was sold at auction for the net sum of \$25.17 and this sum credited to her account with the Custodian. This is her only credit with this office.

There are no claims on file against Miss HOSHINO.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
