Life Insurance: No life insurance was declared by the above Japanese person when she signed our Form J card under date of July 22, 1942, certifying that she had no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area of British Columbia, but in a letter dated January 25th, 1946, The Prudential Insurance Company advised us that they had received a request from Mrs. Nuis Kitagawa for the Cash Surrender Value of a policy on the life of her daughter, Sadako Kitagawa, the amount being \$63.31.

We authorized the payment of the Cash Surrender Value of the above-mentioned policy direct to the Evacuee in our letter of January 31, 1946, to the Prudential Insurance Company. Under date of March 5, 1946, we were advised by the Prudential Insurance Company that they had forwarded a cheque for \$63.31 to Mrs. Nuis Kitagawa, thus closing the matter of life insurance.
