GENERAL SUMMARY

Ginpachi NAKAMURA died at the Hastings Park Clearing Station, Vancouver, B. C. on August 14, 1942. At the time of his death he was 23 years of age and unmarried. He is survived by his mother, Riye NAKAMURA, file #10645.

The deceased made no declaration to the Custodian and no assets belonging to him have come under the control of this Office.

The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim for \$80.00 to cover the funeral expenses of the deceased. They were advised that we were not aware of any assets belonging to Nakamura from which to pay their claim. A claim for an unstated amount was also filed by the Provincial Board of Health, T. B. Unit.




