In reply to your letter of June 13, 1946, please be advised that I have made application for repatriation to Japan on the next boat.

In view of this fact, I am anxious to settle my debt to Mr. Mickey Murakami, of Slocan City as soon as possible.

If the Dept. of Labour sanction their approval in their recommendation that this debt be paid, may I advise that the cheque covering this amount (\$220.00) should if possible, be made out to Mr. Mickey Minoru Murakami of Slocan City.

The reason for this is that I am at present on maintenance, and if I were to receive this money, it would be considered as income, and jeopardize my maintenance, as I would have to live on these assets, and would be unable to repay this loan.

I trust that the outcome of your negotiations with the Dept. of Labour are favourable on my behalf. Also if such is the case, may the above request be complied with.




