GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Shozo KAWATA, Reg. No. 03037

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 23, 1942, in which he stated that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever.

On March 8, 1943, he made application for refund of his one per cent wage deductions for 1941, and on April 12, 1943, the refund of \$5.93 was received and credited to the account of KAWATA. This money was remitted to him on May 9, 1945.

A copy of letter from Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada shows that this man made application for the cash surrender value of his insurance policy #2,032,393. We informed the company that the Custodian had no objection to payment being made direct to the policyholder. This policy had not been brought under the control of this office.
