The following information on the CHIL (or CHI) Family
investigation was prepared by the Bureau dated November 7, 1942.

- (1) **James CHIL** (Page No. 12407, File No. 2270), age 40,
husband of **Edna CHIL**, (2) below. Worked at 218 South
Street, Vancouver, under name of **Joseph** for 14-
month period April 27, 1942. No evidence of owning
any real property. Registration Card in File 2270 (CHI
Edward) should be transferred to File 2270 and File 2270
closed.
- (2) **Edna CHIL** (Page No. 12723, File No. 12406), age 34,
wife of James CHIL, (1) above. Lived with husband at
1212 Fourth Ave. E., Vancouver, of which she is the re-
gistered owner.
- (3) **George Edward CHIL** (Page No. 23223, File No. 12407),
age 27, adopted son of above couple. Worked for his
adopted father (who was probably the brother of his real
father **Thomas CHIL**, in Japan). No evidence of owning
any real property.
- (4) **Edna CHIL** (Page No. 23221, File No. 12406), age 40,
wife of George Edward CHIL, (3) above. Lived with husband
at 218 South Street, Vancouver, of which she is the re-
gistered owner.
- (5) **Edward CHIL** (Page No. 23277, File No. 2149), age 20,
son of above George Edward and Edna CHIL, (3) and (4).
Worked for E. G. Felt, at Vancouver, B. C.
