Regarding the above matter I had this all settled before evacuation here.

This person "Z. Nishimure" sold his house upon evacuation and thus paid me Two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) of which I had to pay Two hundred (\$200.00) to the person I borrowed in order to loan him. Also he has been sending the remaining Fifty dollars (\$50.00) each month in small amounts to my husband in Internment for his personal expenses: which clears him for the amount which was charged against him.

I believe the above explanation will clear your file.
