

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
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Noboru NOMURA

This man who was evacuated on February 24th, 1942 signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 18th, 1942. In his declaration he reported ownership of a Philco 8 Tube radio valued at \$98.00 and an electric heater valued at \$6.00 left with the Mayo Lumber Co. Paldi, B. C. *There is nothing further on file in regard to this.*

On October 22nd, 1942 he requested shipment of two wooden boxes 20 x 20, 3 ft. high, one cardboard box, one wooden box 20 x 20, 4 ft. high and one trunk. Instructions were given by the B. C. Security Commission to William Kenyon of Paldi to ship these but Kenyon advised on November 11th, 1942 that he had been unable to find any of Nomura's effects. Nothing further appears on this file in regard to these chattels.

The sum of \$4.70 was received from the Provincial Government being refund of one per cent wage deductions for 1941. This money was credited to the account of Noboru NOMURA.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information of file.
