





PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARYRe: OMAE, Hachiro - Reg. No. 03042.

This former sawmill worker signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 8, 1943 from Lempiere, B.C. He was evacuated on March 17, 1942.

CHATELS: He declared a few chattels stored with his former landlord T. A. Horzen at 540 Princess Avenue. In July 1943 these were removed to our Warehouse and sold by auction for the net sum of \$15.50. A suit case and basket cannot be accounted for. It is possible however that they may have been included with something else in the auction. It is also to be noted that Mr. OMAE was in the office before he returned to Japan and had no complaint to make in connection with his chattels.

SPECIFIED

ARTICLES: OMAE declared that he also left a radio with his former landlord T. A. Horzen. This radio was not picked up at the same time as the chattels. No explanation was given. Before leaving for Japan Mr. OMAE asked that we recover the radio. On investigation it was found that Mr. Horzen had sold the premises at 540 Princess Street and his whereabouts are unknown.

MONEYS

RECEIVABLE: Before returning to Japan, OMAE turned to this office a notice stating that he had the \$34.00 refundable to him as Savings Portion of Income Tax, for 1944. This is filed in Envelope No. 478 in the Safety Deposit box.

Refund of Income Tax for the year 1944, amounting to \$18.85 and for the year 1945, \$13.75, have been received from the Department of National Revenue and credited to this account.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

While reviewing this file it has been noted that OMAE has been credited with a Cheque Protector, sold for \$15.50, gross, in Auction Sale Vancouver 39, January 31, 1945. He did not declare one and it does not seem at all probable that a sawmill worker should possess one.

It is also noted, in reviewing the original auction sheets, that the Auctioneer confused 11757 with 7257 and 10727, both of which had goods sold in the same auction. Both of these files have been reviewed and neither declared a cheque protector. It is possible however, that it may belong to Kikajiro TANAKA, File 10727 who owned a fish and grocery business and declared such things as an adding machine, desk, etc. all unaccounted for.

In the meantime, the cheque protector is being placed in Chattel Suspense Account as "UNIDENTIFIABLE - Vancouver 39".
