I agree this claim is correct, but at present I have not the funds to give you a cheque in settlement. The amount of \$700.00 that I woe to Mr. Hayashi is the balance of the wages of which he worked at my sholesale "Coast Growers Produce". I had an understanding with him being very good friends, I could repay him when I had enough funds to carry on with my own business. But this war and the evacuation made all the troubles for me. When peace time comes I will repay Mr. Hayashi as soon as I can, and I'm sure that Mr. Hayashi will agree with this and understand the whole situation. So please do not both with the case any more. I cannot pay the money for the duration of the war, cause we are just barely making our own living here in Alberta.

I have answered your letter of December 29th, 1942, long ago, you should have received it before February 4th, 1943, if I'm correct.

I hope I have given you the correct and full information regarding the case. If not write to me again and I will give you as much information as I can.
