



Re: Cameron Lake Logging Co. Ltd.

We enclose herewith cheque in the sum of \$135.65. This cheque contains certain wages due to Japanese formerly at Cameron Lake Logging Co. Ltd. for services rendered during the month of January, 1942. It also includes the sum of \$150.00 for Mr. Hideo Terakita covering the month of February, 1942. We understand that Mr. Terakita's registration number is 07298, file number 8016, and that he registered a claim for this amount with your Claims Dept.

^{May 1944?}
Under date of 7th May you lodged a claim with us in respect of Masao Terakita amounting to \$400.00 in respect of remuneration for the months of January and February, 1942. This amount passed through the books to the credit of Mr. Terakita but in view of the fact that Mr. Terakita is indebted to the company for considerably more than this amount, we have applied this amount on his balance and would ask you to be good enough to advise Mr. Terakita accordingly. We would point out that Mr. Terakita is a shareholder in Cameron Lake Logging Co. Ltd. and that we shall be making a final report to the Custodian within the course of the next few days. It may be that as a result of our report there will be funds available to distribute to Mr. Terakita in his capacity as shareholder in excess of the amount of his indebtedness to the company.

Dear Sir:

Your file has been under review and for your information we give below a brief resume of the contents thereof.

Real Property: In the declaration of assets and liabilities ("JP" form) made by you on the 23rd March, 1942, you stated that you owned no real property (land and buildings) in the protected area of British Columbia.

Personal Property: You also declared that you owned no personal property.

Bills Receivables: You did not declare anything under this heading but this office collected wages due to you by the Cameron Lake Logging Company in the sum of \$13.20, which was credited to your account on the 19th June, 1944.

Liabilities: A claim of \$4.00 made on behalf of Komura Bros. was rejected by you and claimants were so advised.

Funds: There is a balance of \$13.20 standing at the credit of your account at the present time and as no further entries are expected we enclose our cheque in your favour for this amount and will close your account.

This would appear to account for all property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this, we enclose a stamped addressed envelope for your convenience.
