

We are in receipt of your letter of March 21st together with copy of letter from the Custodian, setting out claims lodged against the above mentioned, requesting if they are correct and if so, cheque should be made out to the Custodian in payment of same.

// This man agrees that the claims set out in the Custodian's letter are correct. However, he states that he is unable to make payment of the claims as there are six members in his family and his monthly rate of wages with the Commission does not exceed \$55.00 and it takes all his earnings to maintain his family at the present time.

It is doubtful if any payment on these claims shall be made by this man unless there is a change in his financial condition, and this would only obtain in the event of him securing outside employment which would insure a larger revenue for his labor. //
