GENERAL SUMMARY

Kitaro FUJIWARA died at New Denver, B. C., on August 6, 1946. He is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Kiyoko Mukai, Lemon Creek; Masako Fujiwara and Yukiko Fujiwara, New Denver, B.C. His wife, Tamayo, predeceased him.

At the time of his evacuation, Kitaro FUJIWARA signed a "No Property" card and no assets are revealed on the file.

The following claims were filed against the deceased:

1. Provincial Board of Health.....	\$2,943.00
2. Royal Columbian Hospital.....	170.20
3. M. Hishiguchi Co, Ltd.....	174.10
4. B. C. Security Commission (funeral expenses, Tamayo Fujiwara)	50.00

These claims were admitted by Kitaro Fujiwara but he advised that he had no means of meeting this huge debt. The creditors were advised accordingly. A further claim of \$80.00 has been made by the Department of Labour for recovery of funeral expenses to cover cost of burial of the deceased. They are also being advised that no funds are available from which to pay the claim.

The file reveals that the deceased had a life insurance policy with the Monarch Life Assurance Company but, from a telephone conversation with the Company today, it was learned that the policy was terminated by the Company for non-payment of premium in 1944.

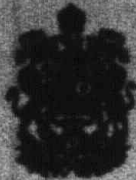
