Your file, however, shows that the sum of \$6.42 was credited to your account as refund of mage deductions for the year 1941 received from the Pro-Wingston Covernments of British Columbia. . In her declaration to the Gustodian, your sife stated that you had an account with the Royal Bank of Canada, Main & Haptings, Vancouver. This did not come under the control of this office. Your wife also declared two Monarch Life Insurance Company policies, a Torkshire Savings & Loan Association policy and a Pacific Mutual Benefit Association policy, all on your life. In Movember, 1945, Mesure. Compbell, Brander, Fisher & Associate sent to this office the sun of \$80.96. This can wan the believe remaining from \$250.11 which these solicitors had received on your behalf upon surrander of Share Certificate No. 3616, forcative Sevings & Boon Association, after the deduction of \$100.15 which they had outd to the convent Life Insurance Company in settlement of arrears and interest on premium on Policy P29856 on the life of your son. At your request we paid Meanre. suppolit Breater, Planer & McMaster their fee of \$12.50 from your Conds in According to information supplied to this office, the sum of \$421.37 to standing to the oradit of yourself and your brother, loshing, in the Yorkshire Savings & Loan Association account. If it is your desire to withdraw Misse funds it will be necessary for you to forward to the forest a Davings & Loan Association your Share Certificate and a completed cash withdrawal form signed by yourself and your brother. The cheque covering these funds would be payable to yourself and your brother and would be forwarded through the office of the Chevodiene Your account shows a gredit balance with this office at the present time of \$74.90. These funds are free from engumbrances as far as this office de courses It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and in order that you may confirm thim we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope. PERSUNAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 23, 1942, in which he stated that he owned no property of any kind left in the protected area.

He later requested this office to apply for the refund of his one per cent wage deductions for 1941, and the sum of \$6.42 was received from the Provincial Government and credited to his account.

His wife (File No. 4575) declared that her husband had a bank account at the Royal Bank of Gamada, Main and Hastings, Vancouver, with a balance of \$500.00. This did not come under the control of this office.

His wife also declared two Houseon Life Insurance Co. policies, a Torkshire Savings and Loan Assoc. policy and a Pacific Mutual Benefit Assoc. policy, all on the life of her husband. On August 17, 1945, Campbell, Brazher, Fisher and Mosseter, wrote this office in regard to the cash surrender value of a Yorkshire Savings and Loan Assoc. Share. They stated that the value of the Contistication held by this man with the Yorkshire Savings & Loan Assoc. were 3647.90. On November 21, 1945, Messrs. Campbell, Brazier, Fisher &M Glaster informed us that they had received from the forkshire Savings & Loan Assoc. the sum of \$230.11, upon surrender of Share Certificate No. 3618. They stated that they had paid the Monarch Life Assurance Co. the sum of \$149.13 in settlement of arrears of premium and interest on Policy No. P92856 on the Life of INIZAWA's son (apparently Masaki, born 1935). The balance of the money received was \$80.98, which was paid to this office. From this sum we paid the solicitors their fee of \$12.50 at the request of IRIZAWA. : On Rebruary 15, 1946, the Torkshire Savings a Louis Association confirmed the withdrawal of the \$230.11 and stated that an amount of \$421.37 is standing to the credit of the account of Sawaichi TRAZAWA and his brother Toshiso IRIZAWA. The brother's file is No. 6950. Insurance policies and securities did not come under the control of this office.

The Monarch Life Insurance Company reported three policies: Nos. 113525, 70881 and 92856. The latter, according to information given in the preceeding paragraph is on the life of his son.

An extractt on this file states that this man holds 50 shares in the Deep Bay Logging Company. These are probably the same shares reported by his wife, who stated they owned an interest of \$2,000.00 in this company. No funds have been credited to this account from the liquidation of this company up to the present time.

This file shows no other property.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.
