The Government of Canada acknowledges that the sum of \$100,000.00 has been advanced to the Government of Canada for the purchase of gold bullion in Canada as described in the Schedule attached to this receipt. It is agreed to remit the net proceeds of such property immediately, or upon legislation if such action is required, to Japan under arrangements made with, and approved by, the United States Government and the Military Authorities in Japan. Provided that from the proceeds of such property there shall be retained such amounts as are required to repay advances made by the Government of Canada by way of Legislation Grant.


